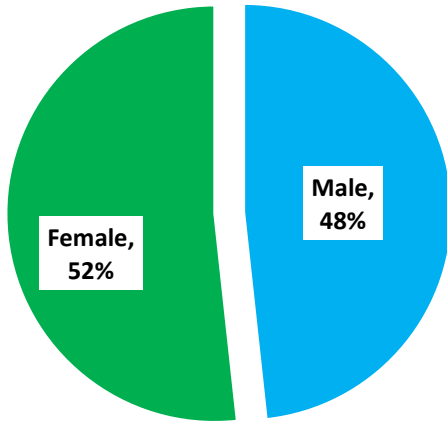

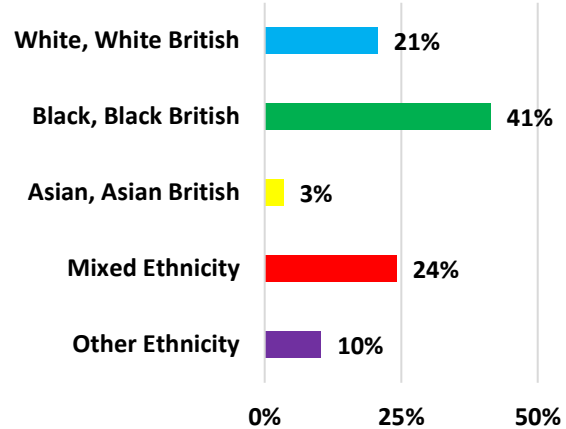

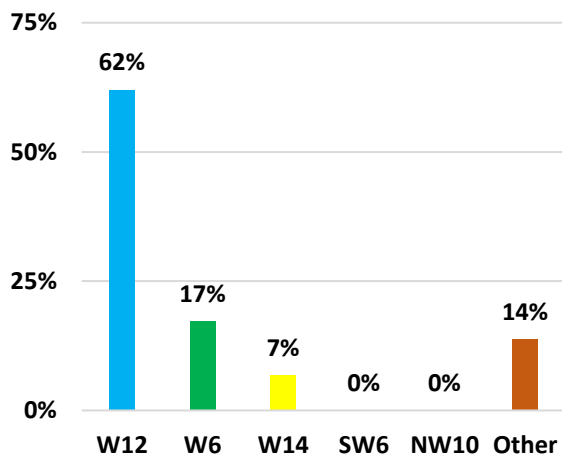
Gender



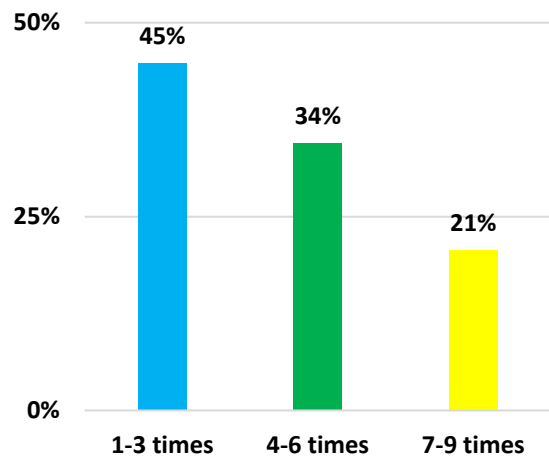
Ethnicity



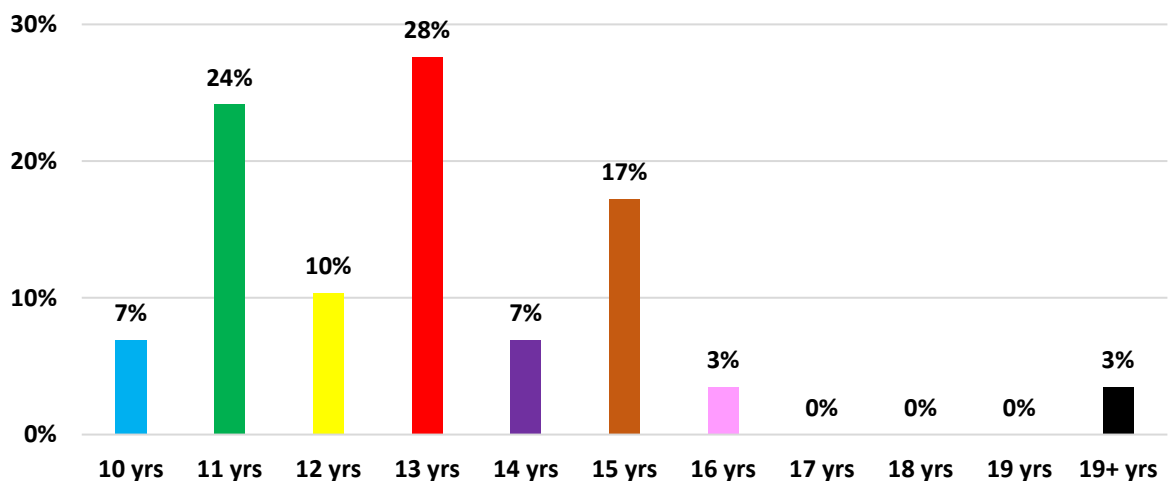

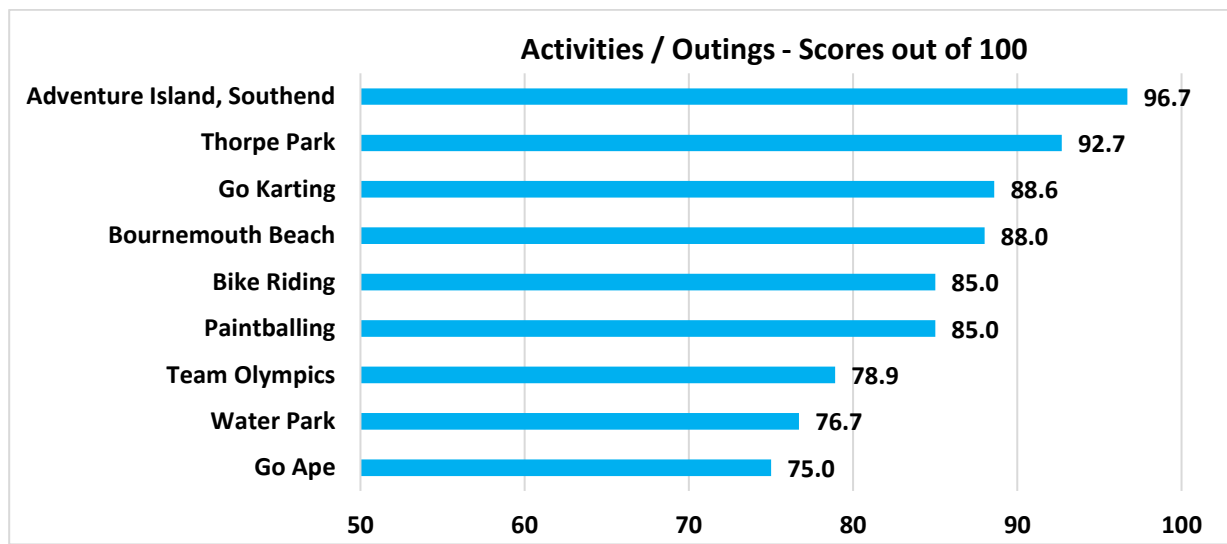
Frequency of Attendance



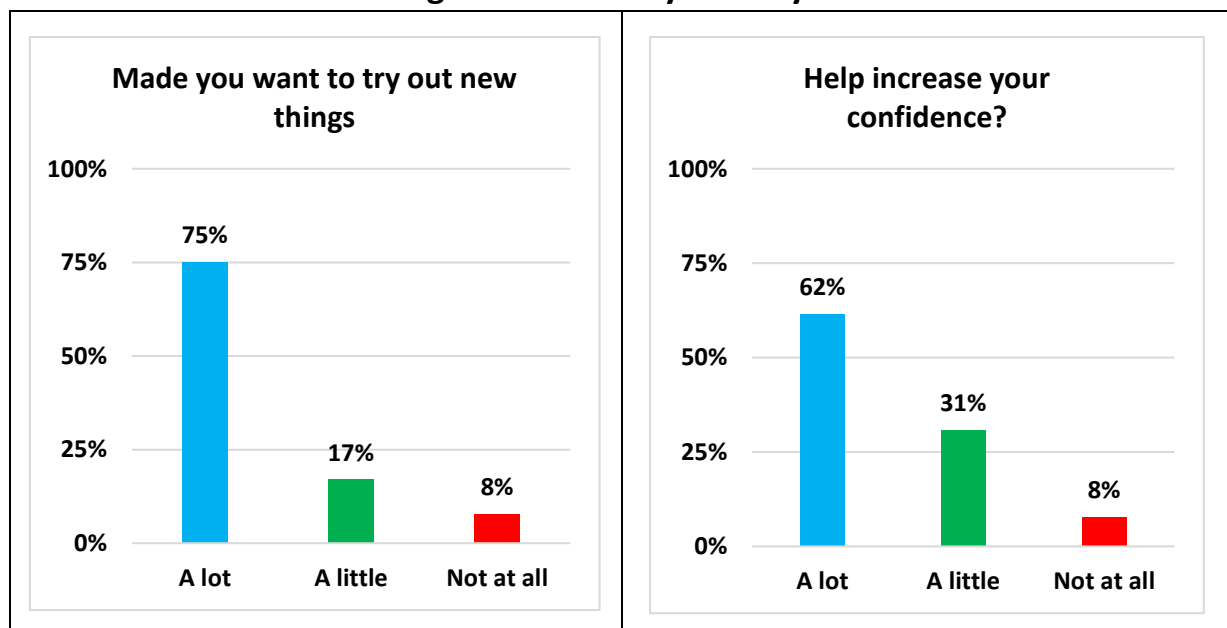

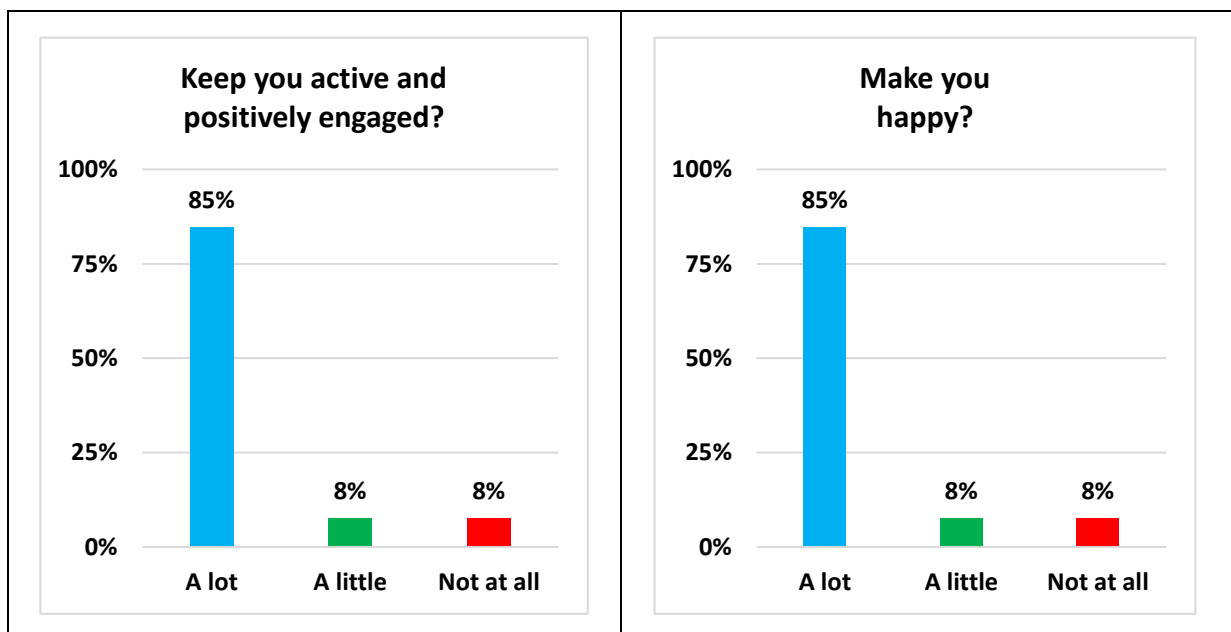
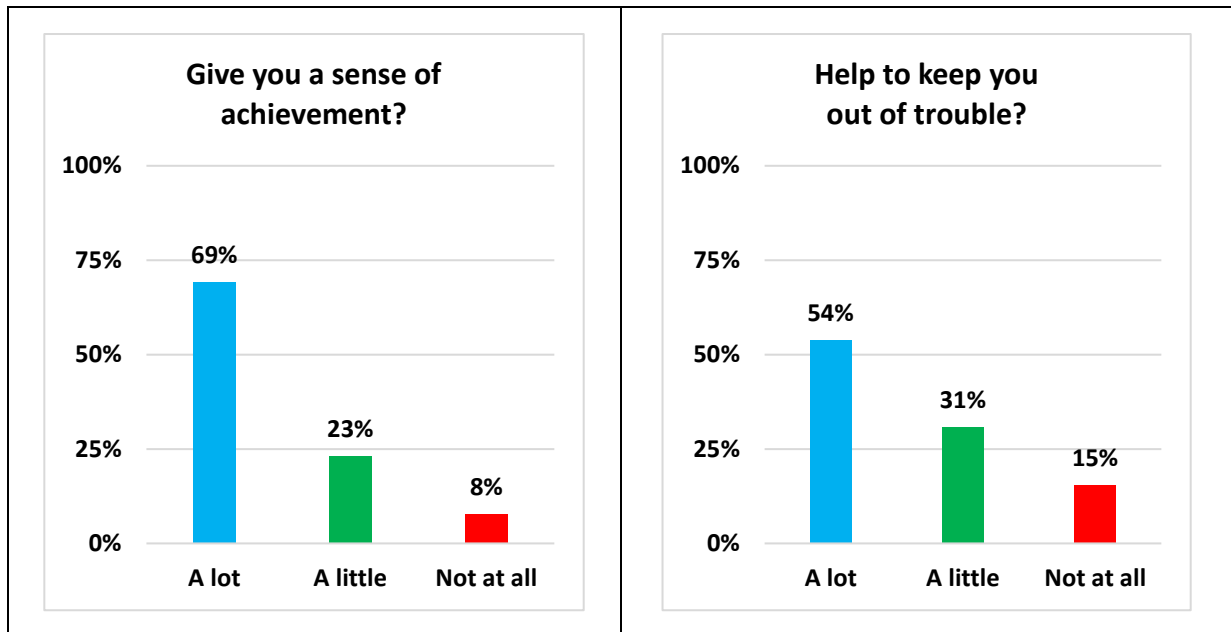






### Did being on the Holiday Activity Scheme:





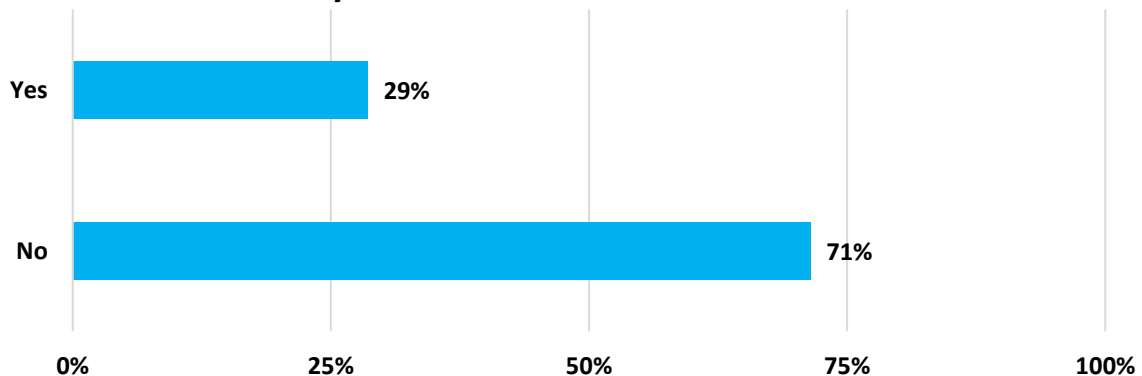


### Why do you think holiday schemes are important for young people like you?
