44 attendees -- Average daily attendance: 18.7 -- Take-up of places: 83.7%

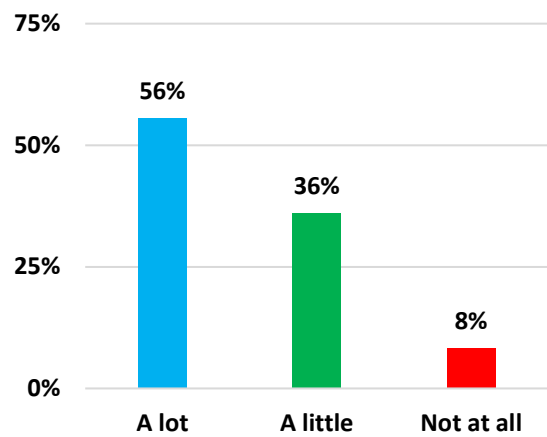
