## Who comes to the Sulgrave Senior Club?

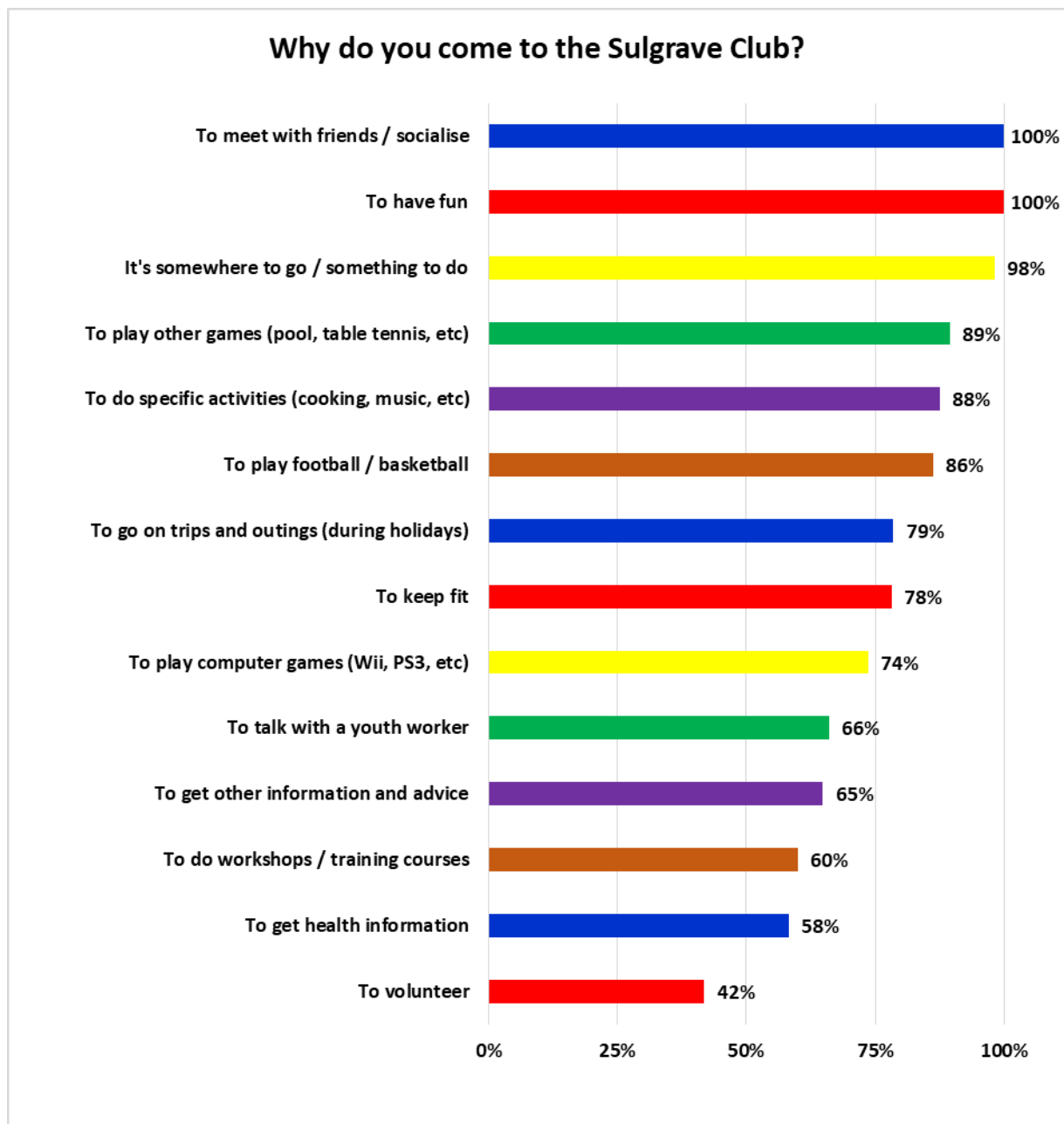
