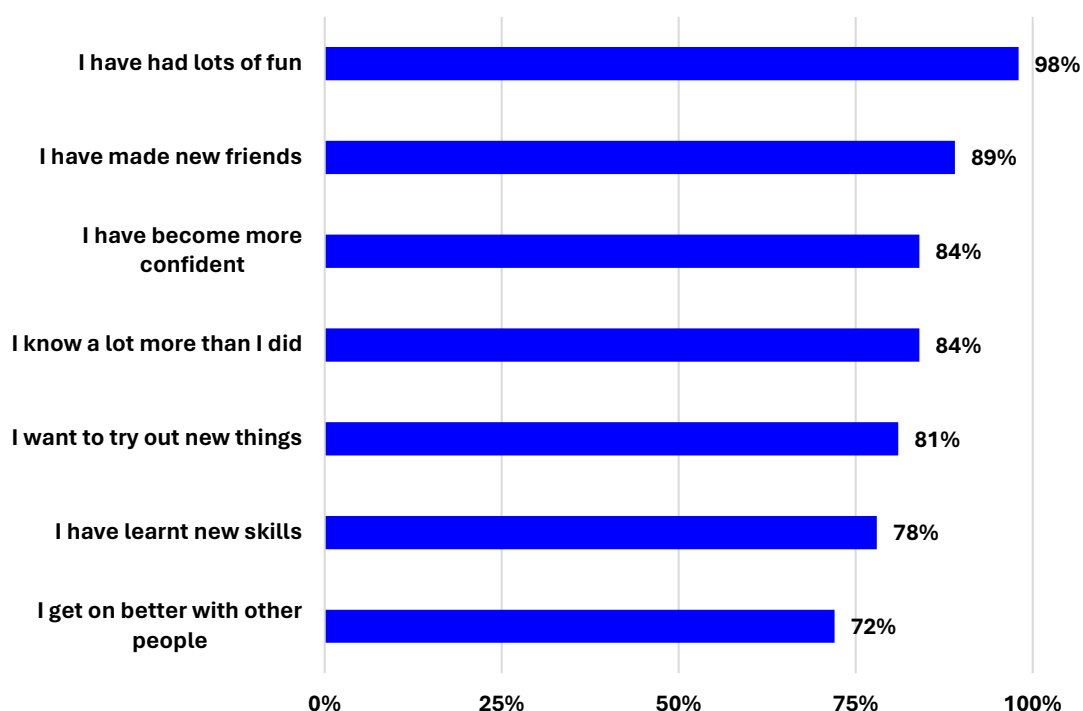

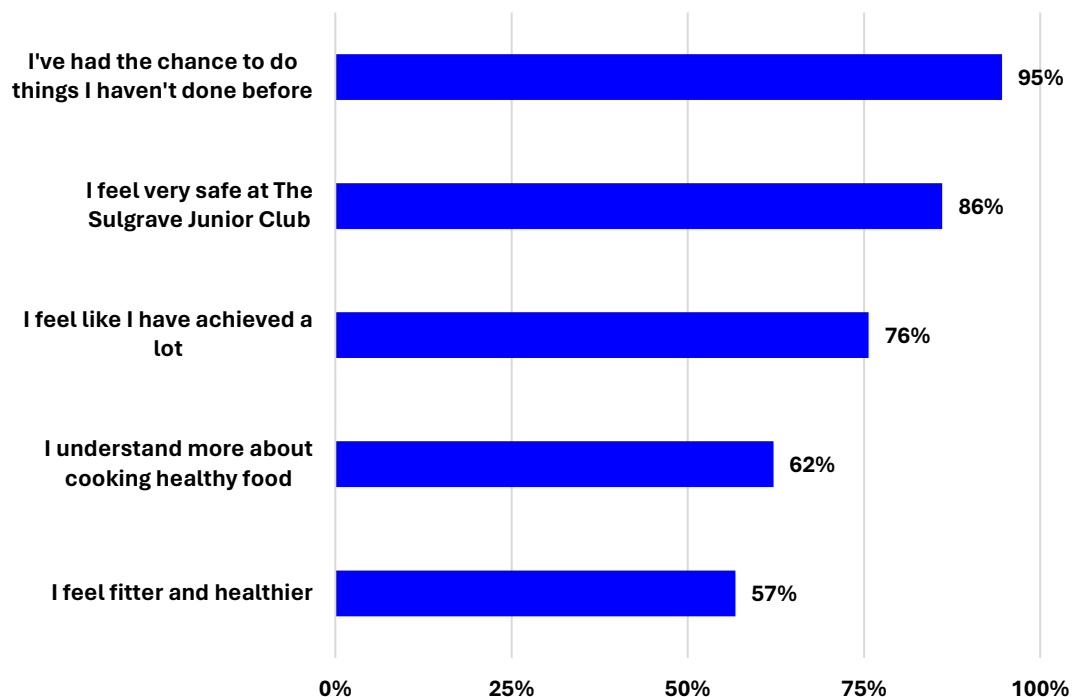


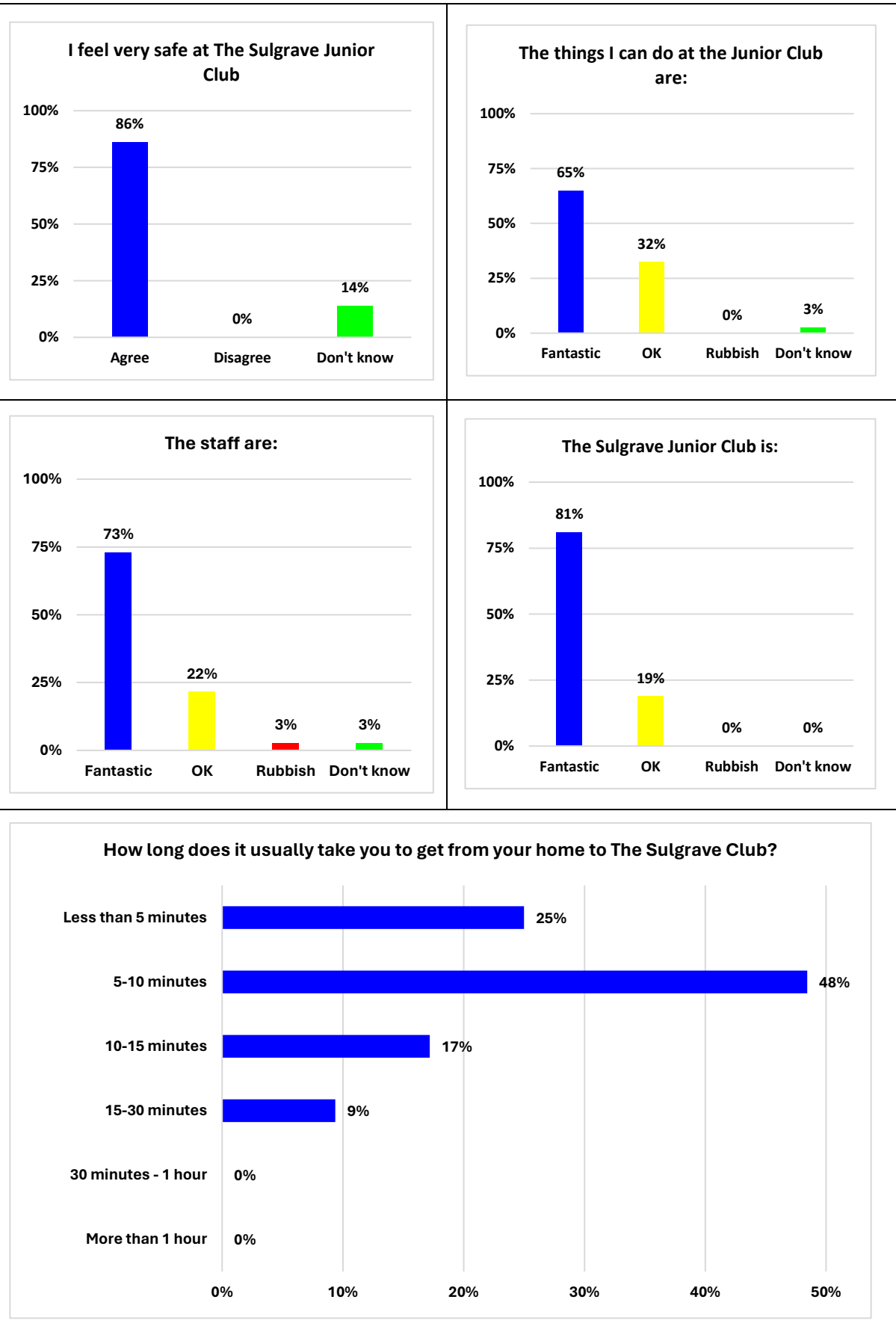

(37 respondents)

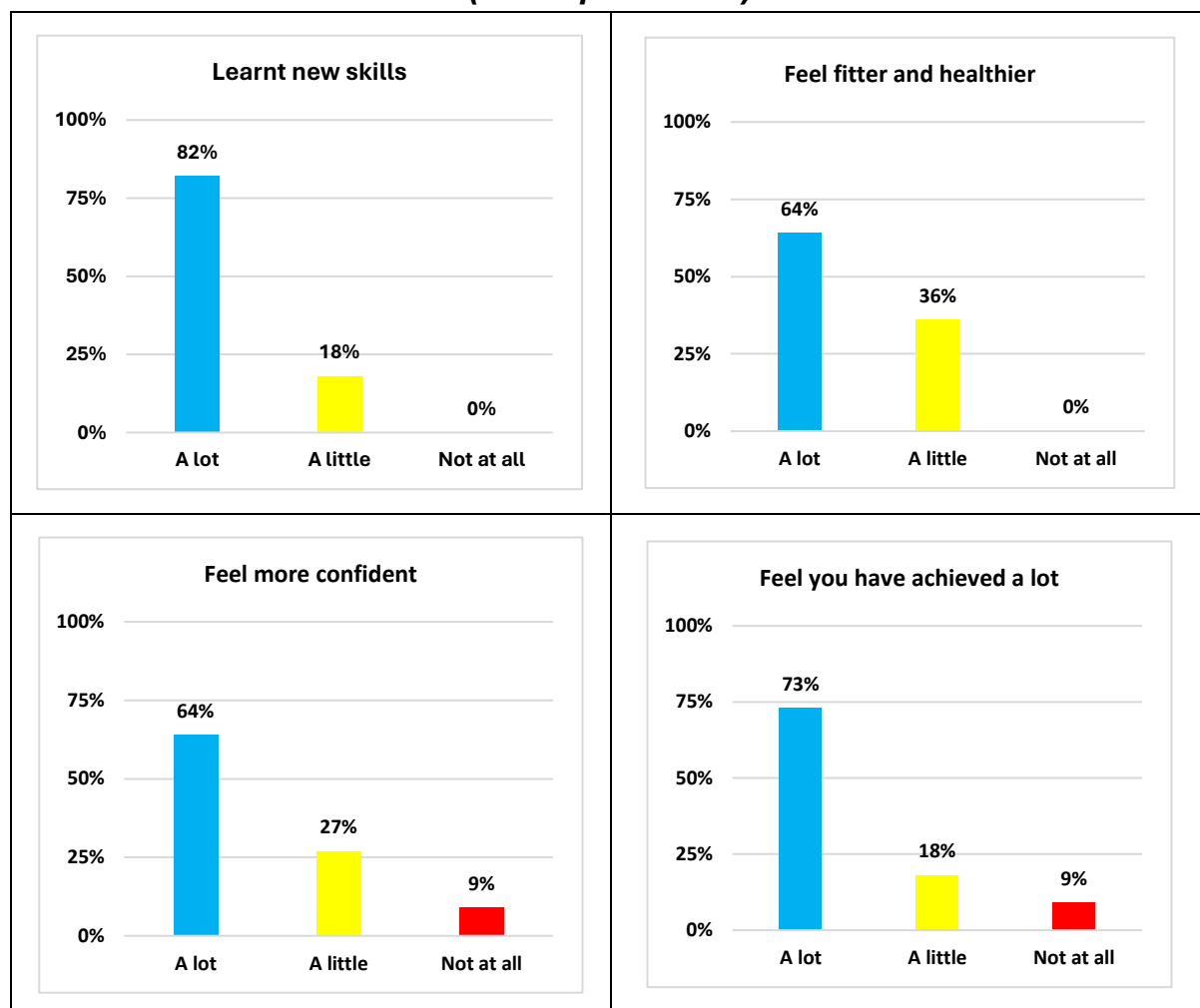

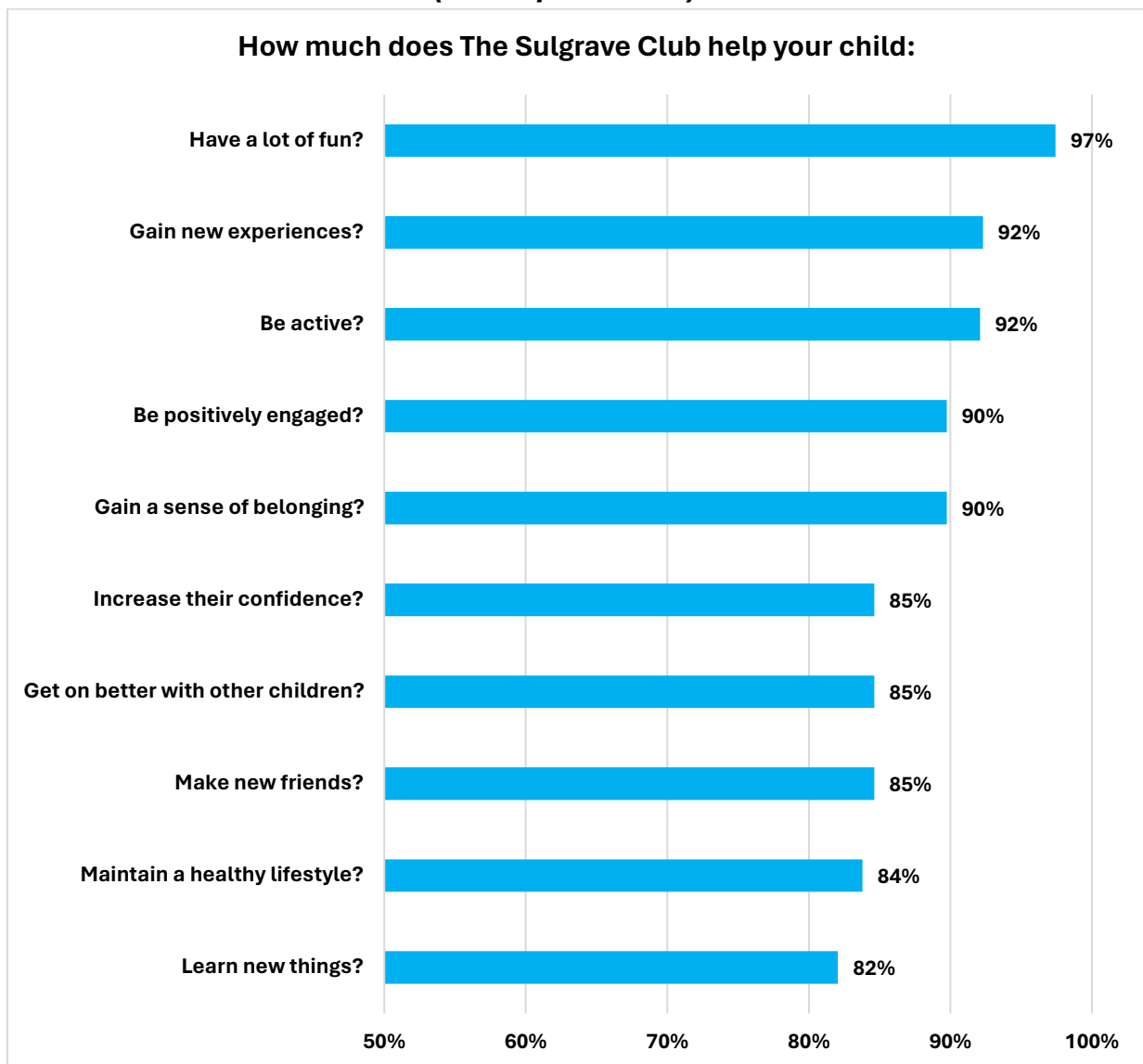

Did you yourself, or other members of your family, benefit from your child / children doing Sulgrave activities?

- Yes taking to them outside is good for our kids
- They provided kids to go out like cinema or balling
- So it saves my time to teach my child's maths which is a difficult task for me
- Seeing your child happy what else could i ask for.
- Having time to spend one on one with younger child.
- You provide my children with opportunities to learn new skills, develop social connections, and engage in positive, structured activities outside of school. Additionally, this gives me some time for myself or to focus on other responsibilities while knowing my children are in a safe and enriching environment.
- Helps with my work commitments and my child's confidence

- As a single father, I get a couple of hours to myself after work, this helps a lot
- In the holidays it's hard to find things to do with the kids. Options are somewhat limited but Sulgrave offer a nice variety of activities every holiday so we benefit from Sulgrave helping us keep our daughter entertained and providing her social activities with her friends that don't break the bank
- It's great for the kids to have something to do with their peers and it's not expensive.

- My child has never been bowling, childcare is helpful, good place for my child to meet new friends

- My son always safe going to Sulgrave and happy with the activities on offer. He often tells me about the fact he has the opportunity to cook as well as play games and hang out with friends
- Having a peace of mind knowing my teenage son can go out and be in a safe environment, with my daughter it was more about her having somewhere safe to go to burn off extra energy as her behaviour can be challenging when she is under stimulated
- "Gives the children a safe and fun place to go. Helps making new friends. I always know they are safe."
- It's somewhere fun for them to go and they enjoy it
- I know she's happy to attend the activities and I know she's safe
- My son isn't allowed to play outside with neighbours, as I did as a child due to where we live. My son has attended many different specific activities, and hasn't enjoyed any particular activity enough to want to keep going. Plus the cost of these activities can be quite high. At Sulgrave, he is managing to mix with children from different schools and ages, giving him a chance to experience what it's like to 'play out' without being on the street vulnerable to everything that is dangerous about being out these days. When I looked up and found out what Sulgrave offers, I was so excited to sign my son up and to see how he gets on in this type of environment. My son is extremely shy and he is loving it so far, and I hope he continues to do so.
